## ***LIONS PUSH EAGLES TO LIMITS IN WET OUTING***

The Narooma Lions have proved too strong for the Sea Eagles in the wet on Saturday.

In greasy and blustery conditions at the Bill Smyth Memorial Oval, the Lions got the edge on the Sea Eagles by 20 points in the senior contest, while the Eaglettes women's outfit secured a comfortable win over the hosts in the women's game.

The senior clash favoured the hosts narrowly 12-12-84 to 9-10-64.

With driving rains and wind howling from the south both teams were up against it from the outset, but the Lions were confident on their home ground to kick a one goal advantage in the opening quarter.

It was the second quarter when the Lions really made their break to the front, kicking five goals to two over the visiting Eagles to take a near-30-point lead at the main break 56-28.

The normal names were on the scoreboard with the Lions reaping the benefits of Bermagui pick up Simon Mackie.

Mackie joined with prolific Narooma midfielder Luke Talty and Hayden Lang to command play as the trio kicked three and two goals respectively to lead the scoring for the hosts.

Tathra's own attacking forwards were still in good stride as Louis Coulton and Dean Gartside both bagged three goals apiece.

By the third quarter the Eagles had rallied and were able to slightly reel in the Lions, out-kicking their hosts by a few behinds to start closing the gap.

The trend continued into the final quarter where the Sea Eagles kicked two goals to one, but the deficit had been too high at the main break to close in given the fierce midfield hussles and slippery conditions.

In the earlier women's game, Tathra had been the dominant team despite the conditions, holding the hosts scoreless in the first quarter and building to a narrow lead by the main break.

By the third quarter the visitors had the pace and tone of play under control, out-kicking the Lions two-to-one and then ramping up the attack in the final quarter to finish off a 7-7-49 to 2-4-16 lead.

Sam Crowley had once more led the charge with the boot, kicking three goals, but she was ably supported by Louise Russell, Eliza Terrey, Cymmon Parker and Tarni Evans.

The Eagles also had a dominant display in the reserves, winning 15-10-100 to 2-2-14 with the Lions kept scoreless until after the half-time break.

All three senior Tathra sides are now right in contention near the top of their respective tables.

Tathra will head to Eden this weekend, while the reserves have a bye.

# ***DIGGERS DON'T SLIP UP DESPITE DOWNPOUR***

The Diggers proved too good for Eden in the wet on Saturday, but the reverse was true in the women's clash.

In a low-scoring encounter in driving winds and smatterings of rain, the Merimbula Diggers bested the visiting Eden Whalers 6-15-51 to 1-1-7.

Both the goal and the behind for the Whalers came in the third quarter after struggling to find any forward momentum against the Diggers.

Jarrold Moore was the sole goal kicker for the visitors, while Dan Edwards led the charge for the host team, booting four goals on the day.

The Diggers were largely in control from the outset, but even if the field were empty it would have been challenging to kick goals.

With the Whalers providing good resistance the hosts weren't able to gain any game-breaking momentum and took a 20-point lead at the first break.

Then in the second quarter, despite a weight of possession, the Diggers were only able to extend their lead through a smattering of behinds.

The Whalers came out of the blocks well in the third quarter to find their few scoring opportunities, but the Diggers soon resumed command of play.

It was in the last quarter that the hosts sealed the result, kicking two goals and a couple of behinds to lock in a 50-point lead as the clock counted down.

The Merimbula club didn't have it all its own way, going down in the women's game by almost 80 points 11-13-79 to 0-1-1.

The Diggers ladies were out-classed by the strong Eden contingent in a physical, but disjointed clash.

Ally Crowe stepped up in a big way for the visiting Eden side when marks were hard to come by and ball contests became scrappy on the wet ground.

Crowe helped cover the goal square for the visitors, kicking two goals alongside Chelsea Cassie.

Meanwhile, it was Eden goal-kicking prodigy Kamilla Grubescic still on top of the game, booting six goals.

It was a similar scenario in Narooma where the Lions proved too strong for the Tathra Sea Eagles in the senior men's match, winning by 20 points.

However, the ladies game in similar fashion favoured the visitors with the Eaglettes claiming a comfortable win over the Lions.

The Panthers had a bye in the top grade, while the ladies side had a narrow four-point win over the Broulee/Moruya combine.

The Pambula reserves had a faultless win over the Giants, bagging 99 points, while keeping the hosts scoreless with Angus Tarpey leading the charge with seven goals.

The Panthers host Merimbula on Saturday.
