SOUTH COAST CULTURE UNDER THE SCG LIGHTS

When the Sydney Swans run out for the Marn Grook game against the Carlton Blues on Friday, June 1, they'll carry a piece of the Far South Coast out with them.

The Swans Indigenous guernsey, a special guernsey they will wear as part of that match, has been designed by Tilba-based artist Cheryl Davison.

Davison is originally from the Wallaga Lake region, and plies her trade up and down the South Coast.

The Swans found Cheryl through the Blak Markets, an organisation that supports small Aboriginal businesses.



"I sometimes do the Blak Market," Ms Davison said. "The Sydney Swans absolutely loved my paintings, and it went from there."

The guernsey design is striking, with a black swan cutting through the Swans' traditional red and white colours.

"I had to think about that a bit, and we've got a South-coast Dreamtime story about how the Black Swan was created," Ms Davison said.

"That's my story about the Black Swan, it's really important.

"I stylized the swan the way I normally do with my art. I made it as bold as possible, and used some of the Aboriginal motif in the design."

Davison said the South Coast was a big part of the design process.

"Every part of my art is influenced by the South Coast," she said.

"My art is about my heritage, the Dreamtime stories from the South Coast region, and the South Coast people.

"It's good to see South Coast culture being put on the map."

Davison will travel to Sydney for the event in June, courtesy of the Sydney Swans.

"I've got 30 tickets for all my family to attend the game," she said.

"I also get to go to dinner with Adam Goodes and Michael O'Loughlin in the official dinner before the game.

Davidson said she will be proud when the Swans run on to the SCG in the guernsey, but it's her family's response she's most looking forward to.

"For me, it's all about pride," she said.

"I'll be looking forward to seeing the expressions on all my nephews and nieces' faces. To know they're so proud of me, and to feel they're a part of the game.

"It's a little bit overwhelming. It was only when I saw Lance Franklin in the jersey that I realised how great this opportunity is.

"I've had some really great feedback from everyone."

LIONS GET REVENGE FOR ROUND-TWO THUMPING

The Narooma Lions rallied from a 22-point halftime deficit to stun the Merimbula Diggers 15.8 (98) to 12.12 (84).

A four-goal burst from captain/coach Simon Mackie early in the fourth quarter keyed the win which saw the Lions remain in the top-two of the SCAFL ladder.



The Lions entered the game desperate for a win over the side that touched them up in round two of the competition, and a quick start suggested they were up and about. Early goals to Luke Talty and Jai Reed had the Lions purring, as their commitment to the contest had the Diggers on the back foot.

The Diggers worked their way back into the match however, as a series of easy misses from the Lions gave the visitors a sniff. That sniff became reality, as the Diggers kicked three unanswered goals to take a three-point lead into the first change.

The second quarter turned into an arm wrestle, with both sides struggling to score in the early goings. The sides traded goals, before a Merimbula blitz at the end of the second quarter saw them jump to a 22-point lead at half time.

The Lions started the third quarter brightest, as Ben McCulloch and Simon Mackie kicked early goals to bring the Lions back to within two goals.

The Lions were still looking for a spark in spite of the two goals, and they would get one through a melee in the midfield.

The Diggers would kick a goal off the ensuing 50-metre penalty, but the Lions had the better of the quarter from that point, kicking two more goals to trail by just a single point at the final change.

The Lions were held to just one behind in the last quarter in their round-two loss to the Diggers, a message that was repeated in the three-quarter-time huddle.

Simon Mackie would make sure history did not repeat itself, as he grabbed the game by the scruff of the neck early in the fourth.

Mackie's first of the quarter was a beauty, as he sunk a set shot from outside 50 to give his side the lead. He wasn't done there, as two more marks inside 50 had the Lions up by 17 points.

His fourth sunk the Diggers, as he took another mark from outside 50 before sinking a Buddy-esque goal to give his side an unassailable 23-point lead.

The Diggers didn't go quietly, as they kicked four last quarter goals of their own, but goals to Liam Clothier and Jai Reed made sure of the 14-point victory.

Coach Simon Mackie stepped in for regular coach Jason Sauluma on the day, and said he's happy to hand the reins back over next weekend.

"It was big shoes to fill, but we got there in the end, so I think I'll leave it at one-for-one," he said.

"Our coach from last year sort of stepped back in as a bit of a voice on the sidelines as well. Just another smart head around the game."
