PANTHERS POUNCE ON EAGLES IN FLIGHTY CONTEST

The Tathra Sea Eagles have been handed their second loss on the trot over the weekend.

Playing the Pambula Panthers at the Pambula Sporting Complex, the Panthers were able to more than double Tathra's scoring efforts on their home turf to win 8-17-65 to 4-6-30.

The midfield was swamped from the outset as Pambula fronted up immense resistance in the central clearances to post an early lead.

The Panthers had pushed the first clearance forward into its own front lines and claimed a goal through young Angus Tarpey within the opening 30 seconds of play.



The Sea Eagles rallied and worked hard through the back lines, but it didn't stop the Panthers posting a further two behinds before the Tathra outfit could get a kick on the scoreboard on Saturday.

The teams then settled in to a back and forth rhythm for the remainder of the opening quarter with the Panthers up by a goal at the break.

Unfortunately for Tathra, the level play just about finished there as the Panthers raced away to a 30-point lead at the main break.

Pambula's dominance had mostly come through contested marks in the air, where a height advantage proved extremely useful, but the Panthers also matched in the middle where possession became an arm-wrestle and players like Kye Overend, Dylan Cook and Charlie Shepherd matched up well.

Troy O'Loughlin was again the best for Tathra, but the visitors had trouble getting play into their front lines against Pambula's big backs like Jake Taylor.

Shane Gartside, Tom Lipsham and Danyon Pilbeam furthered Tathra's efforts, but again struggled to find attacking presence needed as the visitors posted just a solitary behind in the second quarter.

Tathra veteran Luke Taylor injected himself in play across the park to find ground for the Eagles, who gained some ground in the third quarter, but appeared to be fighting a losing battle.

Tathra was kept scoreless in the final quarter, while the Panthers kicked a further two goals and a handful of behinds to wrap up the win.

The Panthers faced the Bega Bombers in the women's clash and carded a convincing win 14-10-94 to 2-3-15.

Despite the strong scoreline in favour of the Pambula roster, the Bombers were also celebrating their best score of the season as the club mounted some solid attacking runs against their Panthers opponents.

In reserve grade, the Panthers went down to the Merimbula Diggers in a local derby at Berrambool. The Diggers stole the show 10-4-64 to 4-7-31.

LIONS CRUISE PAST WHALERS FOR SIXTH-STRAIGHT WIN

The Narooma Lions have maintained their hold on top spot of the Sapphire Coast AFL ladder with a 64-point victory over the Eden Whalers at Bill Smyth Oval.

Narooma came into the match on a five-game winning streak, and played a winless Eden team who had struggled to be competitive so far this season.

For the supposed gulf in class between the two sides, the first quarter was tight, as the Lions struggled with their accuracy in front of goal.

Zac Martin managed the first goal of the match after a run of behinds, before Eden answered shortly afterwards through Liam Wilkinson.

The crowd were restless towards the end of the first quarter, as the Lions had only managed 1.7 before a lucky goal to Simon Mackie on the goal line.

Narooma kicked on in the second quarter, as they kicked five-goals-to-one to build a solid half-time lead.

Mackie bagged two of those with strong contested marks, while Colin Fosternally finished off a slick move from halfback with a goal of his own.

Timothy Wong kicked the Whalers only goal, as the visitors trailed by 35-points at the main break.

The third quarter was another tight affair, with Eden kicking two goals to Narooma's one to peg the lead back.

However, they couldn't match it with the Lions, as the home-side started finding space in their forward half to kick away with a 13.21 (99) to 5.5 (35) victory.

Simon Mackie and Jacob Breed both finished with three goals for the victors, while Jeremy Sly bagged two.

Lions' coach Jason Sauluma said in spite of the lopsided scoreline, his side wasn't at their best.

"The boys were a little bit flat today, we had a lot of people out," he said. "We had a few players carrying injuries that pulled out at the last minute wanting a rest.

"We should have some fellas returning back over the next couple of weeks."

Despite the injuries, coach Sauluma said the side had no plans to change their normal game plan.

"We want to try and create as much depth as possible at the club, so we're keeping the same game plan no matter who's in," he said.

"It doesn't really matter now if we win or lose, because we should be playing finals. Now it's about getting our structures right, and making sure the game plan is right."
