However, it wasn't a solo display from Grubescic with Shanise Mongta the best on ground setting up forward plays and even getting a boot on a goal for the day in the 7-9-51 to 2-3-15



Jacqueline Gwen and Talia Westley were also strong contenders for the Whalers, while Amanda Fowler and junior nationals rep Jorja Moore fronted up well for the visiting Breakers.

A surprise upset by Narooma over the Tathra Eaglettes also means that the Whalers have recaptured the top of the ladder on for and against.

In senior play, Panther Jono Di Donato stepped out of the backlines to lead Pambula's goal-kicking efforts on Saturday.

The regular defender took charge up front and headed the Panthers' efforts against the Eden Whalers, kicking five goals in the 9-13-67 to 5-3-33 result.

The Whalers fronted up strong opposition throughout the contest, but couldn't find as many kicking opportunities in front of goals, but Ben Thomas fronted up well with two majors to his name.

The visitors could not build to a commanding lead in the first quarter, getting just one goal clear of the home side.

Unfortunately for Eden, the Panthers did take charge in the second quarter, keeping the hosts scoreless, while adding two goals and a smattering of behinds to their own tally to lead 30-7 at the main break.

The Whalers rallied in the third and kept pace with Pambula's scoring, but couldn't gain ground on the 30-point deficit.

It was a similar scenario in the final quarter with Pambula slightly extending their lead through a handful of behinds as both clubs kicked a pair of goals in the last period.

Best for Eden were some of the young guns in Luke Grewar, Brayden Grimmond and Nathan Sebire.

The Whalers will be at home this weekend to host the Narooma Lions in both women's and senior play. The ladies match takes the ground first at 1.10pm with seniors at 2.30pm.

# ***LIONS SINK THEIR CLAWS IN SEA EAGLES AT TATHRA***

The Narooma Lions have extended their stranglehold on the Sapphire Coast AFL competition.

The Tathra Sea Eagles hosted the Lions at Lawrence Park on Saturday, but couldn't contain the competition leaders in the senior draw, going down 26-15-171 to 11-11-77.

The Sea Eagles have now won just one third of their games, but coach Kev May believes Tathra could still upset some of the front runners.



"We've lost a lot of those games by really small margins," May said. "We just haven't been able to kick the winning score, but we have a tonne of room for improvement, whereas these other teams have already peaked.

"If we can get all our ducks in a row, we could give it a shake."

May said the Sea Eagles had also been plagued by a bit of inconsistency through injury or work commitments, but having everyone on board for finals could tip the scales back in Tathra's favour.

The back line continued to be a strong point on Saturday despite the Lions racing out to a 41-17 lead in the opening quarter.

May looked to players like Luke Taylor, Tom Marshman and Josh Wilkinson, who have all stood up in their roles well.

Unfortunately, it wasn't enough as the long reach of Narooma forward Simon Mackie proved hard to silence - kicking eight goals on the day.

Jai Reed and Clifford Taylor didn't let Mackie claim all the glory, kicking six and four for themselves respectively.

May said it was a hard blow to the Sea Eagles, who had been a dominant force in the competition, winning the 2016 premiership in conjunction with the Bega club players.

However, May said there were positives coming up in the club with some new faces emerging and further opportunities to make adjustments before finals.

"Brenton Mace has been a good inclusion alongside young Zac Harlow at half-forward is an upcoming prospect," May said.

The coach said the key for Tathra now was to focus in on the half-forward line and ensure there was good ball being delivered to the kickers in Dean Gartside and Louis Coulton.

He hoped to get his full team list together to "get 'em all back on the paddock" with "a good run of hard games into the finals" to come.

May said he was particularly looking forward to more tests on the league's bigger grounds like Pambula.

Tathra have also slipped to second - on for and against - after a shock loss to the Lions on Saturday.

Meagan Mackie did most of the damage, kicking four goals for the visitors, while Emma Bunney bagged two as the Lions clinched the game 9-10-64 to 3-4-22.

The reserves had a narrow win on Saturday, locking in a 16-10-106 to 12-8-80 score.
