DIGGING DEEP FOR DERBY

Merimbula Diggers will host the Pambula Panthers, with the senior men's bounce at 2.30pm.

Pambula is coming off a bye, while Merimbula 12.12 (84) defeated the Tathra Sea Eagles 6.12 (48) last weekend. For the Diggers, both Daniel Worden and Jedd Martyn kicked four majors apiece to lead the way for the home team.

The Diggers have now won eight of their 10 games played this season so far. It sees them lock in second place on the ladder behind the clear ladder leader Narooma.

"It was a good day out for the club, we won five of the six games played," club president Jason Raeck said on Monday.



The only game the Diggers dropped was in the ladies, where Tathra is known for its strong quality outfit, evident in the 20.11 (131) to 0.0 (0) scoreline.

Raeck said the game against the Sea Eagles men was a quality game of Aussie rules football.

"Tathra are always out to win it and they came back at us several times during the game," he said. "It was very close at the start but we started to run away from them the later it got."

A disappointing outcome of the game was the loss of Will Regan for the remainder of the season with a broken collarbone.

"He has had to have a plate put in, he did a good job of it," Raeck said.

"There was no malice in it, just unlucky. He's had plenty of bigger hits on him than that and bounced back, it was just unlucky physics this time around."

Another unfortunate loss is Panthers' star pickup this season, former Digger and ruckman Harrison Peters, who coach Paul Noack said cut his foot surfing.

It's hoped Peters will be back for finals should the Panthers make it through, and in the meantime, Tom Ferguson performed superbly in the ruck last start.

"The local derby is always a hard tussle," Noack said.

"I think it will be a close game, we've been really tight all season."

Giving the Panthers something extra to play for, the game will be captain Dylan Cook's 100th for the club.

"Pambula is always tough being the local rivalry," Merimbula president Raeck said.

"There's a lot of history between the two clubs and that shows on game day.

"We're probably going in as favourites this coming weekend, but you never know on the day."

As for the final round encounter with Narooma, Raeck pointed out the Lions' only loss this season was at the hands of Merimbula, back in round two.

"We've been tight all season, but it will be interesting as we haven't seen them in a little while."

At Berrambool Oval on Saturday, the women's game starts at 1.10pm with the senior men from 2.30.

BIO FOR \$380K OVERHAUL

Sportsmen and women may be able to kit up in comfort at future sporting events at Bill Smyth Oval if Eurobodalla Shire Council's bid for a \$380,000 NSW Government grant succeeds.

Boys and girls have been forced to share change rooms at the oval, sparking complaints from sporting groups and parents.

A council spokeswoman said plans included extended change rooms, with two new sets of shower bays and new toilets. Significant upgrades to water and sewer services and a verandah extension were also required.

"The council applied to the NSW Government's Stronger Country Communities Fund in May," she said.

"We expect to hear the outcome of the application during August; total cost of the project is \$479,000 and the council will contribute the balance."



She said the council recognised extra infrastructure was required to cater for the wide variety of users of Narooma's sporting precinct.

Bega MP Andrew Constance has encouraged the shire to apply for state government funding for the oval.

Meanwhile, the Bill Smyth Oval Redevelopment Committee - which is pushing for a major overhaul of the entire complex and fields - lobbied the NSW Opposition on Monday.

You have a netball court sitting over there with no facilities

Committee spokesman Graham Peachey told Shadow sports minister Lynda Voltz "netball players were getting changed in the bushes, had to be chaperoned across the oval to get water, and had no facilities".

Ms Voltz said it was a familiar story, as "44 per cent of sports fields didn't have facilities for women".

"Netball is the largest womens' sport in Australia by a country mile, and you have a netball court sitting over there with no facilities," Ms Voltz said.

Mr Peachey's wishlist also includes a second oval with lighting, a second netball court with change rooms, and grandstand seating.


"This is the most used oval in the shire." he said.

"The group we have together - representing all the different sports codes and community groups - is working with the council to get outcomes for this oval."

Councillor Lindsay Brown attended Monday's meeting and said the precinct would be a major focus of strategic planning for the council this year.

"Council knows how busy this oval gets. In recent times, the increase in the participation of women in sport has provided impetus to focus on this project."
